Science



Our Science focus this term is 'Marvellous Materials' we will investigate why the Robot goes rusty in our story and design him a waterproof coat! The first week after half term is Brain Week! (W/C 29th Oct—2nd Nov) We will be teaching the children about having a growth mind-set and developing our metacognition.

Power of Reading

The Robot and The Bluebird



This half term Year 1 will be exploring the text 'The Robot and the Bluebird.' Throughout the half term each class will be using a range of skills to engage with the story. We will be understanding the emotions of the characters in the book, as well as looking at the author's use of illustration. The children will write descriptive pieces about robots.

Maths

This half term we will be continuing to secure our knowledge and understanding of place value involving numbers up to 20. We will also begin to solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects, pictorial representations and missing problems. The children will also be exploring 2D and 3D shape.

In Geography we will be exploring the different countries in the United Kingdom and their capital cities.
