LIBRARY VISIT

At Malcolm Sargent Primary School, we 'Love to Read' and give your children every opportunity to engage with reading. We aim to ignite their desire and passion to read offering them a variety of experiences to motivate and extend their reading. They may do some topic research, browse the bookshelves and hear an age appropriate story read to them by the librarian.

Children should be in full school uniform for the day please. They should wear suitable walking shoes and bring a raincoat depending on the day's weather. The children may take a small snack/drink with them and it would be helpful if these could fit into their coat pockets.

If your child is a registered member of the library and wishes to bring their library card with them they may take the opportunity to return or check out a book at the time.
