I am delighted to inform you that the choir has been invited by the PTFA to sing at the Christmas Fayre again this year. As your child is a very important and valued member of the choir I do hope that they will be able to attend as it is very important we have as many choir members there as possible

This event is a great way to support the PTFA and the important fund-raising they do for the school and to bring a bit of Christmas sparkle to the start to the festive season. In addition, it is also a great opportunity for your child to develop their performance skills and confidence in singing in front of a live audience.

What to wear

The children should wear a Christmassy top/jumper/dress or a plain top in festive colours e.g red/green/white together with dark bottoms e.g. jeans/trousers/leggings. The children should also wear a red **Santa hat** or other novelty Christmas wear (not too big though!) as it looks very effective for the performance. Please be aware that it does get quite hot on the stage in the Studio and ask that you consider this when choosing what your child will wear.

Preparation of the songs

Your child will be bringing home the words to the songs that we are performing. They need to learn the songs off by heart in preparation for the performance. Please support your child in this and have fun together learning and singing the songs.

On the day

The children should meet with me at 1300 in the ICT suite to get registered and ready for the performance which is due to start at 1330 and will last approximately 20 minutes. The children will be organised to sing and you will be able to watch in the Studio. When the children have finished performing you can take them home.

We always take pride in our Choir performances and they are hugely popular, therefore I do ask that you support us with making sure the children learn the song words, turn up on time and are suitably dressed for the performance.
