CASTERTON COLLEGE RUTLAND - SCIENCE VISIT

At Malcolm Sargent Primary School, we want to 'Engage and Inspire' and give your children every opportunity to engage with every aspect of the curriculum. We aim to ignite their desire and passion to learn, offering them a variety of experiences to motivate and extend their knowledge. To this end, we propose to take your children to Casterton College Rutland. There, they will have a brilliant opportunity to use a proper science lab to conduct an experiment which they will have prepared and planned during lessons prior to the visit. They will have the chance to use the science equipment not available to them in the primary setting including Bunsen burners, which will, in turn, be part of the preparation for transition to secondary school.

On Tuesday 4 December, the children in class Y6D will be going down to Casterton College. We will be walking to the college, leaving school at 0850 to arrive back before lunch. Please therefore ensure that your children are ready to come into school as soon as the gates open at 0840.
