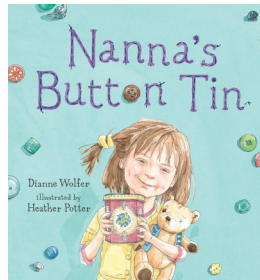
SPRING 1 2019

Humanities

This half term we will be focusing on comparing Sikhism and Christianity in RE. In History the children will be thinking about 'Changes Within Living Memory' and linking this to our story Nanna's Button Tin. We will be comparing technology from the past to now!

Power Of Reading

This half term we will be exploring the story 'Nanna's Button Tin' all about special memories and events within living memory. The children will be writing their own memories of school and comparing this to their grandparents' memories.



Maths

This half term we will be continuing to secure our knowledge and understanding of Place Value with numbers up to and including 100. The children will also be solving 2-digit addition and subtraction problems, using concrete objects, pictorial representations and missing number problems.



Science



Our topic this half term is plants! We will be dissecting plants and using magnifying glasses and microscopes to investigate the different parts of a plant. The children will also be undertaking an experiment to find out what different liquids do to flowers, starting with food colouring!
