'The Lonely Beast'



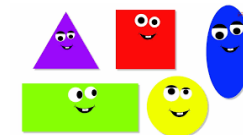
This term our literacy learning will be based around a fabulous book all about a beast on his journey to find friendship, and all the people and places he encounters along the way!
