

The Play

This half term Year 3 will be putting on their performances of 'Jack and the Beanstalk' (as adapted from Roald Dahl's Revolting Rhymes) in their classes. Over the course of the term the children will practising their drama, dancing and singing skills. We are looking forward to working hard for a fantastic dress rehearsal for our houses and an amazing show for parents and families in the evenings.



Humanities: Geography

We will be looking at the geography of European countries and Russia, which is linked to our book, Firebird. We will be using our map skills to identify where in the world they are, the key traditions they hold and even explore their language.

Power of Reading - Firebird

'Who could the culprit be?' "Sire," said the old gardener, "the thief is not a person but a magnificent bird with feathers of fire."

This term we are reading 'Firebird', a celebration of a Russian Folktale and Stravinsky's classic ballet. We will be inspired by the beautiful drawings and gripping story to write letters and a narrative, developing our skills of using speech punctuation in writing.



Maths

In maths, we will be continuing to deepen our multiplication and division skills, looking closely at the 8 times table. The children will also be focusing on time. We will start by looking at telling the time on an analogue clock and progress on to looking at digital time and 24 hour clocks.



Sports

This half term, our main sport is football. The children will be improving upon their skills such as dribbling, shooting and teamwork during competitive matches.



The secondary sport for this half term is indoor athletics. The children will be able to develop their skills of balance and coordination.

PSHE

In our Jigsaw scheme we will be starting the new jigsaw puzzle, looking at our dreams and goals. We will use some of these discussions and activities to look more into e-safety and how we use the internet.
