Dear Parents/Carers of Y3 Children

TIMES TABLES – MULTIPLICATION TABLES CHECK

As you know, times table knowledge is fundamental to a child's mathematical understanding and quick recall of the times tables can not only speed up a child's arithmetic skills when working out number problems, but it can also hugely increase their confidence when faced with a mathematical problem.

Due to the importance of times table understanding, the Department for Education (DfE) has introduced a new Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) which will be statutory for Y4 children in 2020 (current Y3 children). It will take place in June 2020 (exact dates TBC) and will consist of 25 on-screen multiplication questions, with the children being allowed 6 seconds to answer each question with a 3 second gap between questions. They will be based on simple times table facts, such as $4 \times 3 = \dots$.

The DfE has stated that the results of the test will not be published publicly. There is no pass or fail; a score out of 25 marks will be provided to the school on completion of the MTC. The tests will not to be used to compare children; they are for us to reflect on so that we make the most of our provision.

You may notice us taking even more initiative when it comes to learning the tables with more options for home learning. If you are practising with your child, remember you're practising for the benefit of their wider maths education, not for them to get a high score on the tests.

We have signed up to a programme called Times Table Rock Stars which provides pupils with a fun, engaging way to learn and recall their multiplication facts. It also has the added benefit of being able to provide a forum for children to practise their times tables in a similar format to the MTC. You will receive more details about your child's Times Table Rock Stars login and instructions on how you can access this site at home in due course.
