Dear Parents of Current Y5 Children

BIKEABILITY (CYCLING PROFICIENCY)

In Year 5, your child will have the opportunity to attend free Bikeability lessons. This year the course will be run over a two-week period from 3 June to 13 June.

Delivery of the course will be over two days and the children will be split into groups over these dates. Your child will need to bring with them:

- Their bike, which must be roadworthy.
- Wet weather gear, eg a waterproof coat (even a change of trousers if the weather looks bad). Girls may find it easier to wear trousers while on their bike, then change when they return to school.
- A cycle helmet – this is compulsory otherwise your child will not be able to take part.

Please see attached information and consent form from Outspoken Training (the provider of the course) for further information. This course is designed for those children who are already competent bike riders and is not aimed at those who cannot ride a bike.

The children will spend some time on the playground before going out on the road for the rest of the time. A class teaching assistant will be with the children at all times, in addition to two Bikeability staff members.

Your child's bike will need to be in school for both days.
