RE

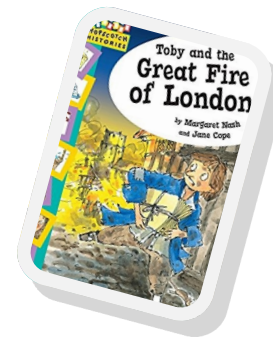

Science
