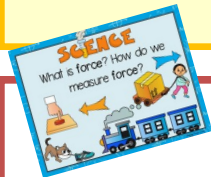

Forces

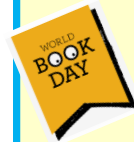
During this term we will be exploring forces and machines. Thinking about the force of gravity, friction forces and air and water resistance

W/b 11 March is National Science week and we will be enjoying some fun, hands-on activities helping us to understand how our brains work and linking with metacognition.

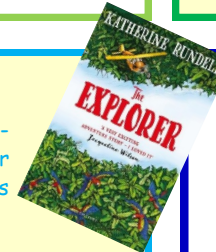


Power of Reading/Literacy

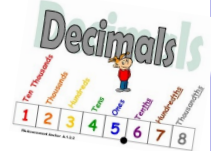


Maths
