To this end we have put together a list of simple costumes needed, which is attached.

All children need to wear plimsolls or bare feet unless stated otherwise.

Please note that some children may be taking on more than one role so may need a change of clothes. If you have any difficulty finding appropriate clothing items for your child, please let your teacher know so that we can ask around to see if anyone else can help.

When you have the costumes gathered please label each item with your child's **NAME** and put in a **NAMED** plastic bag and bring in to school **on Monday 25 MARCH** so that we can hold our dress rehearsals that week. Please do not send the costumes in earlier as we have very limited storage space in our classrooms.

Y4 CINDERELLA COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

Cast List	Clothing Suggestions	School Will Provide
Cinderella	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grey or brown short sleeved or no sleeved t-shirt and leggings (with a few holes and ragged edges would be ideal) • Simple ball gown which can be stepped into quickly and easily on top of above. Ideally white, silver or gold • glamorous accessories such as a bracelet, necklace, tiara and silver ballet slippers or party shoes (but nothing too precious in case it is broken or lost!) 	
Ugly Sisters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undergarments for first appearance – white or black leggings/T-shirt or plain sleeveless top • Simple bright-coloured ball gown (NOT silver, white or gold) that can be stepped into quickly and easily on top of above. • Hoop or tutu skirts that could be put on top or underneath for effect. • Comically outrageous accessories such as wigs, feather boas, large chunky bracelets, necklaces, earrings (but nothing too precious in case it is broken or lost!) • Party shoes 	Huge comical bows
Prince	Smart trousers, white shirt, waistcoat and/or suit jacket	Regal accessories such as a crown, purple sash, gold brooch
Magic Fairy	Princess or fairy dress or ballet leotard with tutu skirt, tights and ballet shoes Tiara and wand	
Jam Maker	Jeans, white or red t-shirt, waistcoat, red neck scarf	Apron
Cleaning Props	Ideally lack leggings or trousers, black or dark coloured plain t-shirt (navy or brown)	Cleaning props such as mop, brush, bucket, dustpan and brush, sponge
Clock	Simple black or dark leggings and matching plain t-shirt	Cardboard clock box or tabard
Rats	Matching leggings or trousers and plain t-shirt in grey, black or brown	
Coachman	School trousers and red t-shirt	Simple red tabards to wear over trousers and t-shirts
Horse	Black leggings or trousers, black or dark coloured plain t-shirt (navy or brown)	Horse's head
Lords	School trousers and white shirt Black bow ties	Regal looking sashes

Ladies	Party dresses - long if possible. NOT white, silver or gold as we do not want it to compete with Cinderella's dress!	
Townsmen	Casual trousers - could be jeans or dungarees Casual coloured t-shirts or shirts Could wear flat caps or hats	
Townswoman	Casual skirts or dresses Hair could be tied back in head scarves Shawls and/or baskets
