PSHE

This half term in PSHE we are learning about relationships. The children will be talking about who is special to them and why they are special. The children will be talking about the word respect and what that means to them.



Hamerton Zoo Park

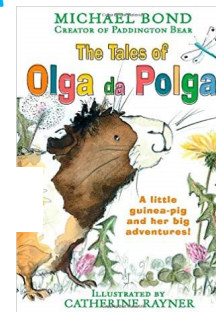
This half term we will be visiting Hamerton Zoo Park. This will allow the children to reinforce their science topic and explore a range of animals including tigers, lemurs, anteaters and tortoises.



Power Of Reading

The Tales of Olga da Polga

During this topic the children will be exploring the adventures of Olga da Polga the guinea pig. We will be writing our own story about Olga using all of the writing skills learned so far. The children will also be writing a fact book about a variety of animals.



Science



Our science topic is 'Animals including Humans'. During this topic the children will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals including, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. The children will also be naming a variety of common animals which are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

ICT

During ICT the children will spend an hour a week in the ICT suite. Here they will learn how to log on with their own password, and how to use a mouse to navigate around a specific programme.



Maths

The children will be exploring multiplication, division and fractions this half term. The children will learn how to use arrays to solve multiplication problems.
