## **ROMAN AND SCIENCE WALK INTO STAMFORD TOWN**

We aim to provide an engaging and inspiring curriculum and give your children every opportunity to engage with a variety of subjects. To encourage this, we would like to become Roman soldiers and Scientists over the course of a morning in May.

Across three dates in May, we have planned a walk for each class into Stamford, when we will follow the path the Romans walked through Stamford, down to Stamford Meadows. Here, we will see the plaque which shows where Boudicca led her rebel army across the River Welland in order to escape the Romans. Whilst at the Meadows, we will become a Roman army, marching in formation, following orders and using the Roman "tortoise shell" technique to avoid attacks. After our exciting Roman expedition, we will magically transform into scientists! As part of our "Plants and Shoots" topic, we will be using quadrats to collect data on the different types of plants species around the Meadows before walking back to school.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, we have reluctantly had to change the dates of these walks from the ones originally published on the curriculum offers. The dates are now as follows:

- Wednesday 22 May - Y3W
- Thursday 23 May - Y3M
- Friday 24 May - Y3G

On the day of the trip, we will be walking into town, leaving school shortly after gam and aiming to arrive back before lunch.

Children should wear full school uniform for the day, as normal., with suitable walking shoes and bring a raincoat depending on the day's weather. If we have an epi-pen or asthma inhaler in school, these will be taken with us automatically but if your child requires any other medication please speak to your child's class teacher. The children may take a small snack/drink with them but it would be helpful if these could fit into their coat pockets.
