Dear Parents of Y6 Children

YEAR 6 PERFORMANCE –THE LION KING

As you will no doubt know from your children, we are preparing for our play which we will perform at the end of this term. We have allocated roles and have already sent home requests for costumes under separate cover.

Please make sure all items are named and/or in a named plastic bag or on a hanger for when they come into school. Please can all costumes be in school in preparation for dress rehearsals the week commencing 1 July.

With regard to the tickets, each class will perform once to parents, in the evening. As there will be fewer children in the studio overall, we will be able to increase the number of tickets available to parents, to four. Unless we are advised otherwise by separated families, we will automatically issue four tickets which will go home with the child and collecting parent. If you are a separated family and wish two tickets to be sent to each parents, please contact the office. We will have a limited number of spare tickets so if you would like an additional ticket, please advise the office. The office will also keep a waiting list of ticket requests at the office so if any tickets become spare we would be grateful to receive them back. Parents with pre-school children can sit those pre-school children on their knees and will not require an additional ticket.

The performance dates are as follows:

6A Tuesday 16 July 2019 at 1800

6D Wednesday 17 July 2019 at 1800

6W Thursday 18 July 2019 at 1800

The play will last approximately one hour.

The children in Y6 will also be performing to their houses during school time. If your children are in different houses, please mention this to their class teacher so that arrangements can be made to allow siblings to see each other perform.

We are expecting that parking will be difficult for these performances and we would therefore remind you that we have agreements with the Danish Invader pub and the owners of the Empingham Road Playing Fields to use their car parks.

We will be making a collection at the end of each performance. Any money collected will be split equally between the CLIC Sargent for Children with Cancer charity and the Y6 group.

Programmes will be for sale on the evening at 30p each and any money raised will be spent on Y6 equipment and/or books.

We are checking our parental consent lists to ensure that all children have permission to be recorded for a DVD which will be on sale to parents. If you have not given permission, it is possible that the performance will not be able to be recorded. We are able to make alternative arrangements for those children whose parents do not wish their child to be recorded, such as full face masks so that they cannot be identified or making them sound technicians. Class teachers will contact parents directly regarding this if there are any queries.

DVDs will be available for you to buy at £5.00 each. If you would like to buy a DVD please order before 0900 on Friday 19 July 2019. Orders should be made via the Parentmail Payment app. DVDs will be sent home early in the autumn term, either via siblings or post.

Again, assuming we have your permission to do so, we will take photos of the children dressed in their play costumes for you to buy. Those children whose parents have not yet given permission will be contacted. The photos will be displayed on the hall doors during the performances and order sheets (with envelopes for the order and payment) will be with the photos. Photos will cost £1 each and will be sent home after the performance, but not before half term.

For the evening performance, please drop off your child at his/her fire door by 1715. Collection after the performance will again be from the fire door.

Face paints will be used for some parts so please inform your class teacher direct if your child is allergic to face paint.
