## **TRIP TO BURGHLEY SCULPTURE PARK**

On Thursday 11 July, children in Year 2 will be visiting Burghley Sculpture Garden and The Gardens of Surprise. At the park, the children will experience a sculpture workshop and explore the sculpture gardens in the morning. The afternoon will then be spent further investigating the grounds and exploring The Gardens of Surprise (water garden).

The coach will leave Malcolm Sargent School at 9.30am and leave Burghley at 2.10pm. Please drop your child off as normal at their classroom and pick up from the classroom at the normal time at 3.10pm.

Your child will require a small rucksack containing snacks, drinks and a packed lunch. We are a healthy school and the packed lunch should not contain any fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate bars. If you have already ordered a hot lunch it will be swapped automatically to a sandwich pack up. However if you wish to cancel or amend this order please contact Mrs Bell at the office by no later than midday on 1 July.

All activities are outdoors and some will involve water. Your child may come to school in home clothes and sensible footwear, but they will get wet so will also need a towel, swimming costume/trunks, a t-shirt and shoes which can get wet, such as crocs or sandals. Flip flops are allowed. If it is a sunny day, please ensure your child wears sun cream and brings a sun hat. Please make sure that all the home clothes are named, and that you have provided a bag into which the wet clothes/shoes can be placed.

If your child requires travel sickness tablets please put the return trip tablets in a named envelope and give it to your class teacher. If your child has an epi-pen or asthma inhaler in school, we will take it with us automatically. If your child has one of these at home but not at school for any reason, please talk to your class teacher as soon as possible. If your child has any other medication needs during the day please mark the slip below and speak to your child's class teacher.

The children will be travelling to and from Burghley by bus and so booster seats are not required.

This exciting visit is kindly being funded for us by the Stamford's Young People's Charity so there will be no charge to parents.
