SATURDAY 22 JUNE – PARADE OF FLOATS

I refer to our previous correspondence and following clarification from Stamford Kiwanis, please arrange to drop off your child with us at the floats on the recreation ground by **1245** on Saturday. This will allow us time to register the children and board them onto the float at **1300**.

We will supervise the children putting together the final touches to the floats, and throughout the parade. We then ask that you meet us promptly after the floats return to the recreation ground, which is estimated to be around **1500**. Please note that a previous return slip stated 1400 as the return time but this was an error. Dancers will stay with Mrs Walkland and the staff team until they are due to perform their dance display at **1630**.

Please also bear in mind the weather on the day. It is important that the children are comfortable and suitably dressed for hot or rainy weather with sun cream applied beforehand if necessary. Children should bring a named water bottle with them. If possible, please ensure the children have been to the toilet before dropping them off at the recreation ground. Public toilets are located by the bowling green on the recreation ground.

Once children have been collected, please feel free to go and enjoy the rest of your day and join in the entertainment! There will be a presentation for the floats and a selection of music and dance displays in the main arena. If you are able to, please cheer on the Malcolm Sargent Active Creative After-School Dance Club which is due to perform at **1630**.

The whole event is due to finish at **1700**. Please come and collect dancers promptly at **1700**. We appreciate that it is a long time for dancers to be with us from 1330-1700. Please ensure they have had a good lunch before they arrive, and pack some healthy snacks and drinks into a small rucksack. The children will be able to have some snacks and a drink once the float parade has finished before they perform in the arena.

We would like to thank you so much for your support with this activity, which we hope will be a roaring success and great fun for everyone involved!
