## **GARDENS OF SURPRISE**

As you know, next Thursday 11 July, Y2 will be visiting Burghley Sculpture Gardens and the Gardens of Surprises. The children are very excited about the trip and it will be a wonderful way to celebrate the end of a fantastic year.

We are writing to remind you of a few important things to remember in preparation for the visit.

Your child will need:

- To come to school dressed in their own clothes, which can get wet. In previous years, most children have worn shorts and T-shirt and suitable footwear, which can get wet and will dry easily (crocs/sandals/jelly shoes).
- A backpack which can be worn comfortably and in which they can carry their belongings.
- To bring a spare change of clothes to put on after they have been in the water fountains, which must fit inside their rucksack.
- A small towel to dry themselves - we are hoping for fine weather!
- To bring their full water bottle and snacks for the morning. We will be able to refill water bottles with drinking water if necessary. If you have a hot lunch ordered, we have automatically swapped it for a pack up for you unless you have cancelled the lunch order. If you have any questions regarding this please contact Mrs Bell at the office. If you are providing your own pack up, we recommend a carrier bag, rather than a lunch box, as this can then be thrown away and will not need carrying around all afternoon.
- To come to school with sun cream applied, with further sun cream in their bag if needed.
- A named sunhat.

On this occasion, the children will not need to bring any money, as we will not be visiting the gift shop.
