Following the UK's departure from the European Union, EU/EEA/Swiss citizens who want to live in the UK need to apply for a new immigration status.

The EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) grants EU Citizens and their families currently living in the UK the right to continue living in the UK after Brexit, and specifically their rights to live, work, study rent, use the NHS, and claim benefits.

Everyone must make an application, including children.

Applications for children are individual and separate from those of their parents. Childrens' immigration status is not automatically guaranteed by their parents' status!

The deadline to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme is the 30/06/2021.

Any EU, EEA or Swiss child who has not applied under the scheme by this deadline – and does not have an alternative legal status (e.g. British citizenship) – may be considered unlawfully resident in the UK and may be prevented from attending nurseries or schools.

Some of the children born in the UK may not automatically be British and need to apply to the EUSS.
