Dear Parents of Y4B Children

SWIMMING

This term, the children in my class will swim from 10 September for ten weeks until 26 November 2018. There will be no lessons during the weeks commencing 22 October and 29 October. All children will swim in the first lesson on 10 September to allow us to assess their swimming ability.

Following that assessment, and if your child meets the national curriculum swimming objectives (being able to swim 25m unaided) then during the nine following lessons, your child need not swim and instead can join the other Y4 children in sports and PE activities. Alternatively he/she can continue to swim weekly. If, however, your child does not meet the national curriculum standard he/she must continue to swim for the remaining weeks or until he/she meets the standard.

Please ensure that on 10 September, and thereafter if he/she is continuing to swim, your child arrives at school with his/her swimming kit (a towel, trunks (fitted please, not surf style) or one-piece swimming costume (not bikinis), goggles if required, and a swimming hat in a bag/rucksack). Girls should have their hair tied back and no children should use any hair products such as gel, wax or hair spray. Children should be able to safely remove their earrings unaided.

Further to the previous letter regarding swimming for the year group, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £2.00 per child per week. Please return the slip below with permission for your child to attend the swimming lessons, with your voluntary contribution. If you wish, you can pay either weekly or in one lump sum. If any swimming lessons are cancelled unexpectedly, we will refund any contribution you have already made for that week.
