

The Sherwood Scholarship

Each year Harrow School offers a Sherwood Scholarship. This award can fund up to 100% of the School fees from Years 9 to 13, plus the option of Years 7 and 8, or both, at a prep school (the prep school is the parent's choice, but we can advise and assist). The level of funding is dependent on parents' financial circumstances and the amount of bursarial support that they are eligible for.

The Sherwood Scholarship is available to boys who:

- are resident in Nottinghamshire, Lincolnshire, Leicestershire or Derbyshire and have been for at least two years prior to application;
- are academically very able;
- have a character such that they are a role model to others and have an appetite for challenge;
- show potential in sport, music, drama, art or some other creative activity; and
- are likely to require substantial financial support.

Interested applicants should apply by early October in Year 6. The application form can be downloaded from the admissions section of the Harrow School website www.harrowschool.org.uk (the relevant section is Year 7 Awards). On receipt of a Scholarship and Bursary Application Form, we will request a reference from an applicant's current school. We then invite shortlisted candidates to a one-day assessment at Harrow School in January of Year 6 and announce the results of our Year 7 awards in February of Year 6.

NB This is not solely a Year 7 award, we also welcome applications for The Sherwood Scholarship from older boys. It is possible to apply at age 13 or 16 for entry to the School in either Year 9 or the Sixth Form. The dates and deadlines for older applicants are as our year 9 and Sixth Form Awards sections.
