





Bus Rules


- The Walking Bus volunteers are there to help and guide you to school safely so you must be polite and listen to them
- It is important that you behave and walk sensibly
- You must only cross roads when you are told to do so
- The bus will leave promptly at 8.30am every day so you must be there on time
- You must carry your own bags to school
